

UPDATED INFORMATIVE DIGEST  
22 CALIFORNIA CODE OF REGULATIONS

The Office of Environmental Health Hazard Assessment (OEHHA) adopts the regulatory levels for the chemical di(2-ethylhexyl)phthalate (DEHP) by oral exposure. On May 5, 2006, OEHHA published a Notice of Modifications to Text of Regulations, renaming “neonatal” as “neonatal infant,” specifying ages for “neonatal infant” and “infant,” and providing guidance for calculation of MADLs for males in the age groups between infant and adult. There have been no other changes in the laws related to the proposed regulations or to the effect of the proposed regulations from the laws and effects described in the Notice of Proposed Rulemaking.
