The California Environmental Protection Agency's Office of Environmental Health Hazard Assessment (OEHHA) is the lead agency for the implementation of the Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986 (Proposition 65).

On September 22, 2000, OEHHA published a public notice in the *California Regulatory Notice Register* (Register 2000, No. 38-Z) announcing a public workshop to solicit input on the proposed process for developing safe harbor numbers. A background document discussing the safe harbor development process and the proposed selection process by which chemicals will be considered is currently available.
